

Oregon Residents Sales Tax Exemption

Oregon residents are exempt from paying Washington State sales tax IF one of the following two items is submitted.

- 1) A copy of your driver's license, or
- 2) A correctly filled Certificate of Exemption form.

Below you will find a form for you to fill out along with instructions and an example. If you choose to do the form, I have filled one out as an example for you (easier than trying to understand all the instructions) to follow.

Fill it out exactly as I have. I filled it out as though I was an Oregon resident so please make sure you fill it in exactly as I have. The only thing different is you will put your name, address, and driver's license information in those fields. But all other fields should be exactly as you see it on the sample form.

Should you prefer not to do the form, you may send a copy of your driver's license.

If you don't send either of the above items, you will be required to pay Washington State sales tax on applicable items.
